

2011 VOYAGEUR SPRING CAMPOREE



WHEN: May 6 – 8, 2011

WHERE: Jax Camp, Sturgeon Bay, WI

WHO: 5th Grade Webelos Scouts, Boy Scouts, Leaders and Parents. Boy Scout Troops should invite their Webelos dens.

COST: \$8.00 per person

Featuring a Pioneering theme, the camporee will allow Scouts to complete most of the requirements for Pioneering Merit Badge. **Participants are requested to complete requirement #7 as a prerequisite. Bring your completed project with you to the camporee.** Saturday morning sessions will focus on teaching skills such as first aid, knots, lashings, rope-making and rope splicing. Each troop is asked to bring materials to construct a full-size catapult as well as materials for each Scout to construct a camp gadget. Go to <http://www.pioneeringprojects.org/> for some great ideas. Catapults will be judged in a camp-wide competition with emphasis placed on correct lashing techniques. Points will also be awarded based on firing your catapult for distance. Camp-wide games will be featured Saturday afternoon.

Camping will be jamboree style. Vehicles will be allowed to unload gear at their sites (weather permitting) and then relocate to a designated parking area. One trailer may be kept at your site if you wish. Leave-No-Trace camping is in effect – no ground fires. Be creative in using off the ground alternatives for cooking and social gatherings (Weber grills, portable fire pits, etc.)

The ever popular Dutch-Oven cooking contest will again be part of the festivities. We will be judging main courses and desserts for both Scouts and Scouters. The Saturday evening meal will be Dutch-Oven pot-luck style with tasty dishes from all participating troops. *Remember, the Dutch-Oven Cooking Contest gives extra credit for Door County ingredients and extra, extra credit for anything picked at Jax Camp like morel mushrooms or asparagus. Bring your best recipes and battle for the title of Top Chef!

Adult Scouters are asked to participate in a camp service project on Saturday. Bring your work gloves, garden rakes, gravel shovels, strong work ethic and a smile. The project will involve finishing up a recently cleared campsite and access trail.

Please register by Friday, April 29, 2011. You will receive additional information once your troop registers at Center for Scouting in Appleton.

Late registration will be at the door on Friday, May 6th from 5:00 to 8:00pm.
