# Register Now for Devil's Lake Hike!!

Registration fee of \$11.00 per person must accompany the registration form. This fee includes multi-color anniversary patch and camping fees.

Registrations should be post-marked no later than September 22, 2010. After that date the fee is \$13.00 per person (including additions or walk ins). Late registrations will be accepted at the event.

Refunds will be issued only if the cancellation is received before September 22, 2010.  
**NO REFUNDS AT EVENT.**

Campsites will be assigned in the order received. Due to the number of registrations - we

cannot accommodate specific site requests. Any units/groups wishing to camp together **MUST** submit registrations in the **SAME ENVELOPE.**

Units/groups may be assigned to nearby private campgrounds, as necessary.

Requests for private campground assignments can not be honored.

To maximize the use of limited facilities, units/groups with large or multiple R.V.'s/campers may be assigned space outside of the park.

## Oct. 1st, 2nd, & 3rd 2010

**Fee:** \$ 11.00 or (13.00 Late fee) per person (fee includes multi-color anniversary patch and camping fees.) \$7.00 for day only hikers (no camping)

Registrations postmarked after September 22, 2010, late fees are applied.

 Saturday, 8:00 a.m.—2:00 p.m.

**Campsites** will be assigned in order received. (Due to the number of registrations - we cannot accommodate specific site requests and units/groups wishing to camp together **MUST** submit registrations in the **SAME ENVELOPE**. Units/groups will be assigned to nearby private campgrounds, as necessary.)

**Caution** — To participate with the Badger Trails "Devil's Lake" activities, you must register with Badger Trails and **NOT** Reserve America or Devil's Lake State Park.

**Directions:**

**From the south on I-90/94:** Take Exit 106 onto Hwy 33. Travel west to Baraboo. At 2nd stoplight, turn left on Hwy 123 South. Follow Hwy 123 south 3 miles to park entrance.

**From the north on I-90/94:** Take Exit 92 onto Hwy 12 East. Travel south about 10 miles to Hwy 159 East. Turn left on Hwy 159 East and proceed for approximately 2 miles to Hwy 123 South. Turn right on Hwy 123 South and follow to the park entrance.

Badger Trails, Inc. is a nonprofit organization that promotes hiking on historic trails in Wisconsin. Individuals or any organized youth group may participate.

Badger Trails members are volunteers who enjoy hiking and outdoor events. They have a desire to promote and share these experiences with today's youth and their families.

We sponsor three events annually - Root River Trail the last Saturday of April, Glacial Trail Backpack Experience the first weekend of May and Devil's Lake Hike the first weekend of October.

All hikers should have good hiking boots or walking shoes to prevent blisters and minor twists and sprains.

Remember to always WALK and stay on the trail. Especially on the West Bluff because once you get to the top, it is almost straight down at some points. All hikers should be careful and courteous while hiking on the trails.

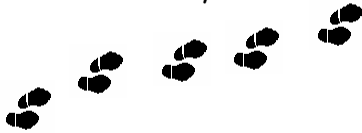

Keep in mind that we do not check messages after the Thursday night before the event.

The emergency number for Devil's Lake is (608) 356-8301. Please have the following information ready:

- Unit #
- City
- Name the unit is registered under
- Name of whom they want to talk to and relationship
- Number to be called
- Brief message (e.g.: what the emergency is or how urgent it is).

Messages for Badger Trails can also be left at this number from 12:00 noon on the Friday of the event until 9:00 a.m. on Sunday.



## Wisconsin State Park Permits are required on all vehicles in the park.

The Park Permits are not included in the registration fee. These may be purchased from the DNR at the park upon arrival.

Vehicles in the Park without necessary stickers will be fined by the DNR.

Sticker fees are as follows:

<u>WI licensed vehicles</u>	<u>Other lic. vehicles</u>
\$25.00/annual	\$35.00/annual
\$7.00/day/car	\$10.00/day/car
\$3.00/hour/car	\$3.00/hour/car

Sticker fees may change. Please check the WI DNR website for current fees. There are only 2 cars allowed per site and no parking on the grass. Additional parking is located in the main parking lots.

Firewood Notice: No out of state or Wisconsin firewood from more than 25 miles outside any Wisconsin State Parks and Forest Property will be allowed to be brought into the property. Please buy firewood nearby or at the property you are going to. Campers may also call the DNR toll-free firewood hotline 1-877-303-9663 for information before planning your trip.

## Special Notices

All scouts are requested to wear appropriate uniforms.

All groups should have all required permits prior to the event.

At least ONE adult is required to hike with each group hiking on the trail.

Each unit/group is required to have adult chaperones for their youths while they are at the dances.

Any Returned Checks will be assessed a \$25.00 NSF fee.

Use or possession of alcoholic beverages and/or controlled substances is PROHIBITED at all Badger Trails events.

Any infraction of this rule will result in immediate expulsion from the event. Plus, you will forfeit any and all rights to future Badger Trails events.

Park regulations MUST be followed at all times.

## Wrist Bands

To identify participants attending the Badger Trails' sponsored event, ALL attendees must wear wrist bands (issued with your packets) for the entire weekend. Those without the wrist bands will be sent back to your campsites to get them.
